Just as you can't get fit by doing a single press-up, you can't develop good pronunciation without lots and lots of practice. **Clear Pronunciation** enables learners to listen to and repeat audio models again and again, to do activities as many times as they like, and to make mistakes without embarrassment.

And, in class, Clear Pronunciation provides teachers with both consistent pronunciation models to drill, and interactive activities to keep students focused, and their interest levels high.

Clear Pronunciation 1 (Sounds) helps learners recognise and pronounce the 43 sounds of English: vowels, consonants and diphthongs. Students learn by watching videos (there are almost 200), working with audio clips (over 1,000) and by recording and listening to their own voice, using the integrated Clarity Recorder.

Learners also meet the target sounds in real-world contexts, and learn to use the IPA and to recognise phonemic transcriptions in dictionaries — a vital skill.


Clear Pronunciation 2
